### Assurance survey

Every year our grade 4 students and parents and our teachers participate in the Alberta Education Assurance Survey. Our grade 4 students and teaching staff will complete their online surveys at school. The survey link will be mailed to all grade 4 parents. Once you receive your access code, please take some time to complete it as it provides the school with very valuable information. The parent voice will not be counted in the results if there are fewer than 6 responses.



Grade 3 and 4 students have been reading the novel A Long Walk to Water, which is the true account of Nya and Salva, two children in Sudan, Africa who walk a perilous journey each day to collect water. Students have spent time learning about Sudan and the children who became known as "The Lost Boys". These children fled the civil war that erupted in their homeland and walked thousands of miles to safety in neighboring Ethiopia and Kenya. Throughout this unit, students have been reflecting on this inquiry based question: How does access to clean drinking water affect quality of life? To honor World Water Day and all the women and children around the globe who walk for water, 3W and 4G participated in a Walk for Water. They carried 8L of water while walking a mile around our school.
