

We are again returning to the practice where our front door (far right door only) will be open during the school day (8:40 am - 3:15 pm). All guests entering the school are required to sign in at the office.

Parents who come into the school to pick up their children at the end of the school day are asked to wait in the main foyer just inside the front doors. This will minimize the distraction to classrooms and allow all of our students to remain focused on the required tasks in their classrooms. We appreciate your cooperation.
