#### **Outcome Based Reporting**

Teachers at Ochre Park School are transitioning to something new; Outcome Based Reporting. Outcomebased reporting is a method of reporting your child's academic progress. It provides parents with detailed information about their child's progress and development. Outcome-based reporting centers on the actual <u>learning outcomes</u> provided by Alberta Education and your child's progress in meeting these outcomes; there is no longer an explicit focus on reporting individual assignments. This approach offers parents a more comprehensive and nuanced understanding of their child's educational journey.
