Volunteers for Field Trips - Our Owl Grown Ups are beginning to book year-end field trips. We will need our wonderful Owl Family Grown Ups to support our learning journey on these trips. The detachment processes Criminal Record Check requests on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays.**

op Driving Loop

Please continue to use the driving loop to drop your child off and pick your child up at the start and end of the day. You can go around the loop as many times as needed. You are also welcome to park in front of the school on the far side of the chain link fence (on the same side as the main road) or in front of the green field along the road.
