## Friendly Reminders



- Please help us keep our Little Owls safe and adequately supervised by dropping them off no earlier than 8:35 am. The morning entry bell goes at 8:40 am. **If you arrive after 8:40 am, please bring your child into the school to sign them in at the office.** Our doors are all locked and you will need to call into the school to have someone open the front door. This is to ensure the security of the building as we cannot monitor the front door for the full day.



# A note about our Driving Loop



Please continue to use the driving loop (indicated by the yellow arrows in the image below) to drop your child off and pick your child up at the start and end of the day. **You can go around the loop as many times as needed** and are asked to do so while you wait for your Little Owl to arrive at the pick-up location (indicated by the green smiley face in the image below) at the end of the day.

If you are dropping off your Little Owl and are walking them to their door, you are welcome to park in front of the school on the far side of the chain link fence (on the same side as the main road) or in front of the green field along the road. **Please refrain from parking in non-parking lot stalls in our parking lot as it can block traffic and clear lines of sight.**

Safety is our top priority and we want to ensure that all of our Little Owls can get to where they need to be promptly at the start and end of the day.

Thank you for your continued care and diligence in keeping all of our Owl Community safe at morning drop-off and after school pick-up, as well as refraining from parking in front of and blocking our neighbour's driveways.
